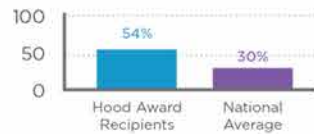


History of the Charles H. Hood Foundation

First Child Health award funded: \$10,000 to Chester Jones, MD. of MGH, for Study of Nutritional Requirements in Disease (2017 equivalent of \$133,428)

Charles H. Hood
A New England dairy industry pioneer in the 1800s, his drive to improve sanitary production and distribution of the milk he sold revolutionized the industry – and dramatically increased the survival rate for infants in the region.



Harvey P. Hood II
Son of Charles H. Hood, he formally incorporated and dedicated the Foundation to improving the health and quality of life for children through grant support of pediatric research within New England. He served as President from 1942-1974.
